## Charitable Trust Services



Individuals create charitable trusts as a way of fulfilling philanthropic goals. A person can create a charitable trust during his or her lifetime, or create one under a will or trust document that takes effect at death.

Charitable trusts are often designed to take advantage of various charitable tax deductions and credits. A charitable trust might exist many years after the donor's death, so that the charity receives ongoing support in the donor's name for years to come. Many donors prefer this to a one-time, lump-sum donation.

Some of the most popular types of charitable trusts include charitable remainder trusts (CRTs) and charitable lead trusts (CLTs). CRTs provide an income stream to the donor and/or family members, with the remaining assets going to the charity after a period of time. CLTs provide a current stream of income to the charity for a period, with the remaining assets passing back to the donor or other beneficiaries at the trust's termination.
