The **Insured Cash Sweep (ICS) Program** offers you expanded FDIC protection in one convenient account. ICS is a smart, secure, and convenient way to place large cash deposits directly through Stifel Bank.

- **Same-day availability** (subject to cut-off time) via Wire and ACH

## How It Works

The program will maximize your FDIC insurance coverage by sending funds — above current FDIC limits — to banks within the network, providing up to \$250 million in FDIC insurance per insurable capacity.

Deposits in amounts less than \$250,000 are sent to each network bank for interest accrual.

These funds are swept into either interest-bearing deposit accounts or money market deposit accounts based on your account choice.
